Rule 1 – No plagiarism

Plagiarism is using somebody else's work as if it were your own.

You **must not** copy parts of (or indeed complete) sentences or paragraphs and incorporate them into your text.

If you want to use something you've read you must either :

- **Reformulate** in other words, or
- **Quote**, acknowledging the source

Rule 2 – Support all claims

If you make any statements of fact they should be based on something you have read, and you should cite them. Articles usually use numbers in superscript and the references can be found at the end.

Well-established facts and opinions do not require supporting references
